Qualified Native American Tribal 8(a) businesses can be awarded sole-source contracts up to \$100M for DoD & up to \$25M for federal & civilian agencies, without J&A, per the revision of Section 811 of the NDAA.

01	AGENCY PROGRAM MANAGER	Establish requirement; prepare SOW & procurement request; identify 8(a) firm — market research.
02	BUDGET OFFICER	Authorizes funding.
03	CONTRACTING OFFICER	Identifies 8(a) firm as the most capable; offers the requirement to the SBA for the 8(a) firm.
04	SBA	Accepts requirements on behalf of the 8(a) firm; authorizes agency to conduct negotiations with 8(a) firm.
05	CONTRACTING OFFICER	Issues RFP to the 8(a) firm.
06	8(A) FIRM	Submits technical and cost proposal to the contracting officer in response to the RFP.
07	CONTRACTING OFFICER	Performs technical and price analysis.

Air Combat Command's mission is to support global implementation of national security strategy. ACC operates fighter, bomber, reconnaissance, battle-management, and electronic-combat aircraft. It also provides command, control, communications and intelligence systems, and conducts global information operations.

As the prime contractor, Puyenpa was responsible for providing the Air Combat Command with the Command Control Communications design, equipment specifications, equipment layout, network connectivity, integration and training. Walker Telecomm played a key role as Puyenpa's subcontractor providing a significant work share of this project. Puyenpa furnished all materials, labor, equipment, facilities and transportation necessary to construct secure Audio Visual (AV) Systems in strict accordance with the design. The basis of design was modeled on the Everts solution set commonly used in industry. The totality of the design and integrated solution include and cover Operations AV System, Non-Operations AV System and Training.

HHS OIG established a new Physical Security program to secure all OIG leased and federally owned facilities nationwide. OIG maintains office locations in Washington, DC (headquarters), as well as over 80 offices located in 10 regions across the United States. The intent of this contract is to install a FICAM compliant Enterprise Physical Access Control System (EPACS) at all sites by the end of FY2024 — approximately 20 sites per year including site surveys, designs, and installations.

As the prime contractor, Puyenpa is responsible for providing the design, ATO (Authority to Operate), systems deployment, operation, support, and maintenance to a sustainable nationwide physical access control system comprised of an access control system (ACS), intrusion detection system (IDS), and internet protocol video surveillance system (IPVSS).

Services include program management; project management; facilities and IT infrastructure assessments; as-is architecture discovery and functional requirements discovery; site surveys; technology studies and analysis; design and installation of new, upgrade, replacement or retrofit systems; Pre-Installation Testing and Check-Out (PITCO); master design and work plan documents; other planning processes and documentation; coordination; procurement; implementation of work plans; testing & commissioning; end user training; as-built documentation and project close out.

Puyenpa Services, LLC provided design-build services for the Horizontal Voice and Data Cabling project at Raven Rock Mountain Complex. The existing telecommunications networks and infrastructure were beyond serviceable life; RRM required new and upgraded horizontal and backbone cable distribution infrastructure and subsequent replacement of all IT networks, telephone, CATV/CCTV and all other telecommunication system cabling (all OSI Layer 1) present within the facility.

Puyenpa provided a design to upgrade the backbone support structure, cable and cable management from the existing telecommunications rooms (TRs) to the equipment rooms (ERs) — plus the design of all horizontal cabling and cable support structures from all work area outlets (WAOs) to IT services through the TRs to the ERs, inclusive of all patch panels, horizontal cables, connectors, faceplates, support structure and management, and fiber and copper jumpers to existing switches in the TRs.

A MILCON project that required building a state-of-the-art mission control facility for the Utah Test and Training Range (UTTR) at Hill Air Force Base, consisting of six phases over a span of two years. The end result dramatically improved the operational capability and flexibility of the Utah Test and Training Facility. Walker Telecomm provided a portion of the design-build services needed for Mission Systems, Video Routing, Telemetry, Video Processing, Recording, Network Storage, Video Walls, Displays, Workstation Consoles and Physical Security Systems, performing in a subcontractor role for prime contractor JT4, LLC.

Deliverables: engineering, approved plans, in-room rack cabinet and workstation console installations, roughed-in communications and network cabling, installation of CFE equipment, termination and connection of communications and network cabling, and successful completion of component-level and acceptance tests.

The July 2019 Ridgecrest Earthquake Sequence caused extensive damage to Naval Air Weapons Station China Lake facilities, including those of the China Lake Range. As part of the earthquake recovery efforts, MILCON P1911 "Range Control Complex Consolidation" delivered a replacement Range Control Center of nominally 45,760 square feet, implementing five test bays, one customer data room, two major server rooms, and multiple real-time operations support rooms. Key to this facility was construction in accordance with ICD-705, enabling implementation of a multiple independent levels of security (MILS) environment aligned with the DoD Joint SAP Implementation Guide (JSIG). Walker Telecomm performed in a subcontractor role for prime contractor JT4, LLC; scope included the design-build of CSI Divisions 27 Communications & 28 Security under two phases of tasking.

Deliverables: Phase I (Design) — project management, requirement analysis, preliminary design, critical design review. Phase II (Build) — build to baseline; development, integration, installation and test; information assurance products; training.

Walker Telecomm played a significant role in this approx. 83,000-square-foot, two-story design-build project, managing two contracts with two separate prime contractors. Walker was contracted by Puyenpa Services, LLC to aid in the design and installation of AV systems and provided audio visual infrastructure, equipment and programming for both operational (command and control) and non-operational systems (conference rooms) — installing miles of cabling, terminations, testing, labeling and reporting for all cabling and equipment installed, including copper and fiber cable, video walls, Crestron switching, and console work.

Walker received a second award from another contractor to furnish design services, labor, material, equipment, supervision, and management for the communications infrastructure including copper and fiber backbone cabling, horizontal fiber and copper station cabling, and Telephone Room build-outs inclusive of all fiber tray, racks and patch panels, patch cords, and equipment grounding.
